A couple of weeks ago, Grace Cummings and Dick McCaffery were well received as they shared their experience and advice with a very attentive group. The bottom line: how to increase the likelihood that one can stay in the game during Congressional and Presidential transitions. It isn't easy to align long-term program goals and short-term political goals, but it's an absolute necessity because that is how our government was designed to work. I appreciated the clarity, integrity, and passion for good government that characterized both speakers that evening.
